Scope of Accreditation

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Referring to ENFSI's Policy for Accreditation (QCC-ACC-001, 4 July 2007, issue no 005) an institute's accreditation should include the frequently performed examinations.

Furthermore ENFSI recognises that a quality assurance system should not be static.

It is ENFSI's aim that member-institutes have achieved or are taking steps towards having achieved at least 50% of their fields of expertise to be accredited.

Only fields of expertise where on average at least twelve examinations per year are performed will be considered.

A continuous increase of the scope of accreditation of an institute should be demonstrated by the institute every year. The scope of accreditation will be monitored through the annual QCC surveys.
